

Buying a lodge at FLUSCO WOOD



All lodges on our site are made to British Standard BS3632, which means they are suitable for holidays all year round, are well constructed and built to last in all weathers. We work with a selection of lodge manufacturers directly, such as Retreat, Pinelog, Prestige and Tingdene among others, to ensure you get the quality of holiday home you deserve.

We're ideally placed; close to Penrith Train Station, the M6 and A66 and only thirty miles from Carlisle Lake District Airport for ease of travel. We are also only a ten minute drive from the Lake District National Park, perfect for walkers and other outdoor enthusiasts: Pooley Bridge and Ullswater are only a fifteen minute drive away.

Due to our woodland setting we have an array of local wildlife as visitors, including many bird species such as woodpeckers, as well as red squirrels. Along with these benefits are the stunning views of the northern fells, Blencathra in particular. We also have dedicated walking areas, including one for dogs, as we are a pet-friendly site. There are also quiet picnic areas at viewpoints across the park, though you will have your own private deck on your lodge to enjoy the scenery as well.



FLUSCO WOOD is open twelve months of the year and is staffed twenty four hours a day for security and maintenance; we also have entrance barriers with CCTV and ANPR cameras for security. We have a dedicated team to maintain the site all year round as well as good working relationships with trusted contractors to ensure all lodges and the site are kept in excellent condition.

Our Site Management Charge covers grounds and park maintenance, use of park facilities, TV and satellite aerial service, water charges, warden services, refuse disposal from central point, fire extinguish service and park lighting. Site Management Charges increase in line with inflation so please contact the Park Manager for the up to date cost. You won't be required to pay Council Tax for your lodge but will be subject to rates as part of the overall park assessment, these change annually. You will be responsible for organising your own lodge insurance and we can introduce you to insurers.

We are happy for you to allow friends and family to stay in your lodge but we are unable to allow sub-letting. You can stay as long as you want at **FLUSCO WOOD** as we don't limit how long you can be here but your lodge can't be your main residence, as proof we require a copy of your Council Tax bill for your main residence.





Things To Do near FLUSCO WOOD

We're lucky enough to be situated close to the Lake District National Park, which affords our lodge owners the luxury of having some of the best country for walking on their doorsteps. With a range of walk types spread across the National Park, there is plenty for all ages and abilities; from short walks around bodies of water like Buttermere or Brothers Water to full day treks in the Newlands Valley or the Helvellyn Range; the Lake District offers it all.

If walking doesn't appeal, then mountain and road biking are popular and watersports are an option. If you want to explore the lake, meres and waters of the Lake District but don't want to take a dip, the Ullswater Steamers allow you to travel on the water taking in the views while seated comfortably (and with access to a bar or at least a cup of tea). Cumbria also has a fantastic selection of cafes, pubs and restaurants for you to visit; we are fans of fine, filling food and good ales and spirits so there is always plenty on offer for you to visit and try.

RHEGED

Rheged is less than ten minutes drive from **FLUSCO WOOD** and is filled with fun activities for everyone. From indoor and outdoor play areas to exhibitions of crafts, art, textiles and even Lego! With a two screen cinema you can catch a new film release, documentaries or a live streaming of a play or concert. They also regularly host exhibitions and events as well as talks and workshops.

On top of all of the activities, Rheged also have their Taste Foodhall and Taste Café, stocked with handmade pies, local cheese and fresh baked bread. The shelves are laden with carefully chosen locally produced ingredients and a selection of beers, wines and spirits. There are also clothing shops, toyshops and even a wool shop!


