A few park rules to help maintain a peaceful and relaxing place to stay:

- Please do not hang clothes or other articles outside your accommodation, use the indoor clothes rack provided.
- Please do not charge electric vehicles from your lodge. The nearest EV charging point is at Rheged Visitor Centre 3.5 miles from Flusco Wood towards Penrith.
- No smoking in any of the accommodation or buildings.
- Please keep noise to a minimum always; and no noise should be audible from your accommodation or around the park between 10:30pm and 08:00am.
- Park your vehicle(s) in the designated areas and please do not obstruct any other road area. Keep off the grass with vehicles.
- Please take your refuse to the park refuse compound located next to the park entrance.
- Pets must be kept quiet (i.e. no persistent barking etc.) and under control.
- Please clean up after your pets (dog foul disposal points are located around the park. Bags can be obtained from reception). You will be fined if you do not clean up after your pets (around the park, and on your accommodation decking)
- Pets <u>must not be left unattended</u> in the lodges at any time.
- Pets must be kept off all furniture and beds, and out of hot tubs.
- Barbeques must only be used on a hard surface and MUST NOT be used on the wooden deck or grassy areas. If in doubt, please ask at reception about a suitable area. Be mindful of fire risks.
- Open campfires are NOT allowed at any time.

- Fireworks and Chinese Lanterns must NOT be used under any circumstances.
- Please observe the 10MPH speed limit on site at all times.
- Please observe the privacy of the Private Lodge Owners by staying on the marked paths and roads and not walking between their Lodges.
- If your smoke alarm or carbon Monoxide detector goes off please exit
 the accommodation immediately and make your way to the evacuation
 point at the laundry block; marked on your map.

General information

Living Room

Heating —Heating can be controlled to your requirements by thermostats on individual radiators, and in some cases a wall thermostat.

Electricity — should there be a power cut please report to reception (in the case of a site/area wide power cut; we will endeavour to do our best to get your electricity back on as quickly and safely as possible). Please be aware during the winter months especially, this rural area is known for weather induced power cuts, and we do are best to mitigate these. Flusco Wood has an emergency generator which is used in situations where there will be an extended period without power. The generator will only be turned on when Flusco Wood have ascertained with the electricity board and local businesses that the issue will not be resolved within the next hour or so.

Wi-Fi – network and password: please see separate sheet for list of networks and passwords. Choose the one that gives you the best connection.

What to do if your smoke alarm goes off - If your smoke alarm goes off and there is a fire, please exit your accommodation immediately and make your way to the evacuation point at the laundry block marked on your map.

If your carbon monoxide alarm goes off please exit the accommodation immediately and head to the evacuation point. Please familiarise yourself with the map to see the most effective route from your accommodation.

Kitchen

Washing-up liquid, dishcloths, a tea towel and a small quantity of dishwasher tablets can be found under the sink, if you require any more of these items (including bin bags) please enquire at Reception.

Dishwasher – please try and put this on to clean any dirty items or leave empty when you vacate your holiday home.

Hob, Grill and Oven – these are supplied by bulk LPG gas and/or electric. Please note these aren't always as powerful as a standard domestic cooker so please allow for a little more time to heat.

A fire extinguisher and fire blanket can be found on the wall in the kitchen or utility room, please identify and familiarise the location of this.

Refuse Disposal

We are committed to helping protect and improve the environment and this includes managing the safe and responsible disposal of all waste. Therefore, we ask that you separate your items into general waste, paper & card, glass, tins/cans, hard plastic and soft plastic and place these in the designated recycling bins situated adjacent to the park entrance. Thank you.

Bathroom

Please do not put any sanitary products, face wipes, baby wipes or nappies down the toilet, use the bins provided.

Bedrooms

A hairdryer is available for your use and can be found in the vanity unit drawer of the double bedroom.

A washing machine, tumble dryer, iron and ironing board are available for your use. Both the washing machine and tumble dryer take £1.00 coins and 50p coins (change is available at reception)

Defibrillator

Should you require in an emergency, we have a defibrillator installed at reception (see pg 1). Upon dialling 999 they can instruct you on how to access this.

- IF YOU SUFFER FROM HEART OR SKIN CONDITIONS, ARE

 IMMUNO SUPPRERSSED OR ARE SUBJECT TO FITS PLEASE

 SEEK MEDICAL ADVICE BEFORE USING THE HOT TUB
- IF YOU ARE PREGANANT PLEASE SEEK MEDICAL ADVICE
 BEFORE USING THE HOT TUB
- CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 8 WHO ARE UNABLE TO HOLD THEIR FACE OUT OF THE WATER SHOULD NOT USE THE HOT TUB
- CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT WHILST USING THE HOT TUB
- PLEASE AVOID SWALLOWING THE SPA WATER
- PLEASE AVOID SUBMERGING YOUR FACE IN THE WATER &
 KEEP LONG HAIR TIED UP

- IT IS RECOMMENDED TO HAVE A BREAK AFTER 15 MINUTES OF USING THE HOT TUB TO COOL DOWN
- PLEASE DO NOT HAVE GLASS CONTAINERS OR ELECTRICAL
 ITEMS IN OR AROUND THE HOT TUB
- PLEASE DO NOT SMOKE IN THE HOT TUB
- PLEASE REMEMBER THESE ARE HOT TUBS AND NOT SWIMMING
 POOLS; DO NOT DIVE OR JUMP INTO THE HOT TUB

HOW TO USE THE HOT TUB

TO REMOVE THE LID, UNLCIP THE 2 FRONT CLIPS &
 CAREFULLY LIFT THE FRONT HALF OF THE LID OVER THE BAR
 ACROSS THE MIDDLE. ONCE FOLDED IN HALF OVER THE BAR,
 LIFT AGAIN SO THE LID IS HANGING SECURELY AT THE BACK
 OF THE HOT TUB

PLEASE NOTE: THE LID SHOULD NOT BE FULLY REMOVED FROM THE HOT TUB (CONTACT OUR ON SITE WARDENS IF YOU HAVE ANY ISSUES)

- WATER TEMPERATURE MUST STAY BETWEEN 38-40 DEGREES
- DO NOT TURN OFF THE MAIN ELECTRIC SUPPLY TO THE HOT
 TUB
- PLEASE TAKE CARE WHEN ENTERING & EXITING THE HOT TUB
 AS THE GROUND MAY BE SLIPPERY
- WHEN EXITING THE HOT TUB SQUEEZE OUT EXCESS WATER
 ON YOUR SWIMWEAR TO MINIMISE WATER LOSS
