Recommendation to download 'Alltrails app' and 'Kamoot App' Wainwrights bagged = Place Fell, Loadpot, Wether hill & Steel Knotts

## Friday

Evening walk Askham Fell (approx. 1.5 hour round trip from Askham village to top of fell & back) Evening meal at The Queens Head, Askham (Dog friendly – book table).

## Saturday daytime

Morning Pastries from Neaum Kitchen, Blencowe Quarry, CA11 0DE (3 minute drive)

- Place fell (starting at Patterdale) Park at Cricket club King George V Playing Field CA11 0PJ.
- Total length Approx 4.5 miles, relatively steep walk but clear paths all the way (circular loop up around and down to the start easy to navigate, great views). Link below to Alltrails map of walk:

• Go back via The Horse and Farrier pub, Dacre, Penrith CA11 0HL. Great selection of drinks and food (dog friendly in the bar area)

## Saturday evening

• Enjoy a well earned rest in your hot tub and order a takeaway delivered to your door (see list of local deliveries on the QR code)

## Sunday Daytime – Loadpot, Wether hill and steel Knotts (5.5 miles)

- Breakfast at Cranstons Cumbrian Foodhall & Café Oswald's, Ullswater Rd, Penrith CA11 7EH. Collect a delicious picnic lunch for your day ahead!
- Drive to Howtown Tea Room, Howtown hotel, Howtown CA10 2ND and park (please note parking is for tea room/hotel user only, so make sue to stop after your walk and support the tea room, it would be rude not to sample a hot sausage roll!).

Set off up the tarmac road towards the start of the walk. Keep left at the start of the path and follow the path to loop round to the right and up the hill. Once up heading straight towards Loadpot, it is easy to navigate onto Wether Hill, and then from there you can see the path down and onto steel Knotts (walk is effectively a horse shoe shape) and back to the Tea room for refreshments!
