

Walk from Flusco Wood to the Boot & Shoe and/or Greystok Castle in Greystoke

Distance: 3km

Time: 45 minutes but allow for up to an hour if you want to take your time.

Start in the Enclosed Dog Walk (located on the map).

Head to the back left corner of the dog walk, where you will encounter the stile (with a dog gate).

Cross the stile and turn left.

Follow the boundary of the field straight down and turn right (staying inside the field) and follow the boundary along to the next gate.

Go through the pedestrian gate (the metal barrier hinges to allow access) and onto the gravel track.

Turn right and follow the path to the next gate by the black barn.

Go through this gate and pick up the footpath on the other side of the black barn.

Follow the path (which runs along the field boundary) until you reach the next stile which has a plank that lifts out of the way to allow your dog through.

Follow the path straight down the fields (do not cross field boundaries at the sides – only the bottom boundaries).

Find the kissing gate at the bottom left corner of the last field (this leads out onto a small, quiet road).

You can turn either way, but right is best. Follow road for about 150m and pick up the footpath that appears on the left.

Follow this down and through a gate. Keep going until you reach a yard (horse stables).

The path goes to the left of the black building you see and goes straight down behind it.

Keep following the path behind the building until you reach the end. Ahead you will see the footpath appear between a large building and a small one.

Follow this and go through the large metal gate with the red sign.

Follow this path until you reach Greystoke Church.

Turn left at the church and follow the road up to the T Junction. Turn right for the Boot & Shoe pub and/or and Greystoke Castle.
