

Staff recommended pubs, cafés, and restaurants (listed in order of distance away). This is not an extensive list and there are many more fantastic places to eat in towns such as Keswick, Cockermouth, Ambleside, and Windermere that we haven't mentioned.

Within 5 miles of Flusco Wood

- **Neaum Kitchen, Newbiggin (and another location in Penrith Town Centre)** – dog friendly, amazing coffees and hot breakfast options. Next to Cocos Gym so ideal for a post work out treat. 1.1 miles away.
- **The Clickham, Newbiggin** – Dog friendly. Country Pub Mediterranean Tapas. 1.5 miles away.
- **Horse & Farrier, Dacre** - dog friendly in the bar, excellent food and views. Great selection of local ales. 2 miles away.
- **Boot & Shoe, Greystoke** – dog friendly, large beer garden with play area. Walkable from Flusco Wood – see our “things to do” for details. 2.2 miles away.
- **The Kings Arms, Stainton** – great Sunday roast and wonderful food during the rest of the week). Dogs in beer garden only – they have a covered and heated outdoor area which is ideal for those visiting with dogs. 3 miles away.
- **The Sun Inn, Newton Reigny** – great atmosphere and delicious food. Live sports available to watch. Good beer garden (dogs in beer garden only). 3.6 miles away
- **Basecamp North Lakes, Troutbeck** – Farmshop and kitchen. Dog friendly in the conservatory. 4.4 miles away.
- **FYR Grill at North Lakes Hotel, Penrith** – amazing food and brilliant atmosphere. 4.7 miles away.
- **Café Oswald's, Cranstons Foodhall, Penrith** – great breakfast, brunch, and lunch options and a good foodhall to wander around after. 4.7 miles away.

Within 10 miles of Flusco Wood

- **The Glasshouse, Another Place, Watermillock** – delicious woodfired pizza by the lake edge. 5.2 miles away.
- **The Dog and Gun Inn, Skelton** – Michelin star pub. Dog friendly, lovely food. Booking recommended. 5.3 miles away.
- **La Casita, Penrith** – Spanish tapas restaurant with great choices and delicious food. 5.6 miles away.
- **The Cross Keys Inn, Penrith** – dog friendly, good food and nice atmosphere. Sunday roasts all day Sunday. 5.7 miles away.
- **White Horse Inn, Scales** – dog friendly. Based at the bottom of Blencathra and very welcoming after coming down off the fell. Log burners and nice food. 8.2 miles away.
- **Mill Inn, Mungrisdale** – dog friendly and well suited for those enjoying a nice drive out or coming off the fells (Blencathra, Carrock, Bowscale etc). Extremely good food (pies recommended). 8.7 miles away.
- **Abbott Lodge Jersey Ice Cream** – ice cream parlour with play area and outside benches to watch the Jersey cows grazing. 8.8 miles away.
- **Askham Hall** – Michelin star restaurant, a wonderful fine dining experience. 9.4 miles away.

- **Punchbowl Inn, Askham** – dog friendly and lovely after walking up on Askham/Helton common. 9.4 miles away.
- **Lowther Castle Café** – dog friendly, very spacious and great food. Lovely after a walk around the gardens and castle. 9.7 miles away.

Within 30 miles of Flusco Wood

- **The Kings Arms, Temple Sowerby** – dog friendly with good parking. Tasty food and homemade produce available for purchase. Good to tie in with a visit to Acorn Bank. 11 miles away.
- **Oddfellows Arms, Caldbeck** – dog friendly, delicious food, good ales, and amazing warm pork scratchings. Enjoy a nice gentle walk around the village or to The Howk (an old Bobbin Mill). Lovely drive there if you go via Mungrisdale Valley. Good options for those with dietary requirements. 14 miles away.
- **Fetherstone Arms, Kirkoswald** – dog friendly with excellent food in a quaint village. Walk along the river in the neighbouring village of Lazonby. 16 miles away.
- **Lingholm Kitchen and Walled Garden, Portinscale** – dog friendly and ideal to visit before or after walking the shores of Derwentwater. 16.7 miles away.
- **Swinside Inn, Newlands Valley** – dog friendly with a stunning setting in the valley. Fantastic food and perfect after a day on the some well-known fells (Catbells, Barrow, Causey Pike, Grisedale Pike etc). 17 miles away.
- **Fox & Pheasant Inn, Armathwaite** – dog friendly with good food. Perfect after a day walking through Coombs Wood. 17 miles away.
- **The Oak Curthwaite & Helm Restaurant** – Two fine dining experiences in one place. The Oak country pub is dog friendly and more casual atmosphere. Helm by chef James Hill is an elegant fine dining experience (not dog friendly). 18.7 miles away.
- **Bassenthwaite Lake Station, Bassenthwaite** – unique replica train used in the Murder on the Orient Express film. Dog friendly throughout and a lovely nature reserve next door. Booking recommended. 21.3 miles away.
